The editorial office has been notified of the following errors.

The authors report a data publication error in the tables. One of the provisions of the State Databases Data Use Agreement (DUA), which the authors signed when purchasing the data, is that no data observation involving less than or equal to 10 observations is to be published. This measure was put in place by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) to protect individual patients' privacy and to prevent the potential disclosure of personal information. In the manuscript, there are some tabulated cells that are in violation of this provision. The tables have therefore been corrected in the online version to be in compliance with the AHRQ guidelines. The authors state that this error does not affect any of the study results or conclusions. In addition, the rows labeled "Wyoming" in Tables 1 and 2 and Appendix Tables 2-4 should have instead shown "Wisconsin" as the state. The tables have since been corrected online.

The number of participants was incorrectly reported as 22,790 in two places. In the second paragraph of the Study Population portion of the Methods section, the number of participants reported should have been as follows: "From December 1999 to July 2018, a total of 22,791 participants were recruited." Likewise, the first box of the Appendix Figure 1 flowchart should have read as follows: " $n=22,791$ Participants recruited up to July 1, 2018." The article has since been corrected online.
